Voter Registration Deadline

In order to vote in the June 7 primary, you must be registered to vote by May 23. Only those voters registered as Democrats or with no party preference will be able to vote in the Democratic Presidential Primary. Please make sure you are registered at your current address. Also make sure you did not accidentally register for the American Independent Party, which is a real (right wing) party. If you truly want to remain independent, register and select "no party preference" on the form.
